The Chamber supports a process that ensures the actions and impacts of any regulatory proposal are fully understood and vetted; a step that appears lacking in this case based on the rapid timeline required by the Dodd-Frank Act.

We also have concerns that the Federal Reserve proposal puts in jeopardy the freedom to contract, which is a basic premise the Chamber believes is critical to good business practices and must be preserved.
