

Steve Martin's "Picasso at the Lapin Agile" Opens July 9th

Denver, CO: July 8th- August 14th, Senior Housing Options (SHO) presents Steve Martin's "Picasso at the Lapin Agile," directed by Terry Dodd.

The production is SHO's major annual fundraiser and builds on the successful run the past two summers of "The Hot L Baltimore" (named "Best Environmental Staging" by Westword, 2008) and "A Hint of Winter," both directed by Terry Dodd.

In "Picasso at the Lapin Agile," comedian Steve Martin turns his sharp, funny mind to a fictional meeting between Albert Einstein and Pablo Picasso in a bar- the Lapin Agile (the "Nimble Rabbit")- in 1904 Paris. As the locals gather to drink, talk and flirt, the two geniuses muse on the achievements of the century as they debate art versus science as the prominent influences on the future.
